Bad Memory by Duane Franklet

When a major computer corporation receives a demand for one million dollars to prevent the destruction of its entire network, troubleshooter Barry Shepard is forced to counter additional threats against his own family.

The Blue Nowhere by Jeffery Deaver

A notoriously sadistic computer hacker, code-named PHATE, is cutting down people all over the Silicon Valley, but L.A.P.D. computer crimes geek and former felon Wyatt Gillette is on the warpath, hoping to bring him down.

Collateral Damage by Fern Michaels

The Sisterhood is asked by a mysterious client to find a computer hacker who has stolen a list of secret fundraisers' names and sold it to an identity-theft ring, and they soon discover that the job is more dangerous than they expected.

Delete All Suspects by Donna Andrews

When a high-tech geek named Eddie ends up in the hospital, the victim of a hit-and-run "accident," Turing the AI computer comes to the aid of her private detective friend Tim to find out who was responsible, an investigation that leads to some of Eddie's unsavory friends who are using his computers in a variety of scams, cons, and other less-than-legal endeavors.

Digital Fortress by Dan Brown

A former National Security Agency programmer threatens to release a mathematical formula that will allow organized crime and terrorism to skyrocket, unless the codebreaking computer that is used to keep them in check--but that violates civil rights--is not exposed to the public.

Firewall by Henning Mankell

nspector Kurt Wallander begins to suspect that there is a connection between a series of crimes tormenting Sweden--the brutal murder of a taxi driver by two teenage girls, the escape of one of the culprits from police custody, the sudden death of man who drops dead at an ATM, a bizarre power blackout, and a grisly discovery at the malfunctioning power station.

The Hanged Man's Song by John Sandford

Computer whiz and professional criminal Kidd and his partner LuEllen investigate the murder of Kidd's old friend and hacker Bobby and the disappearance of his laptop, which contains secrets about Bobby's friends and colleagues, including Kidd.

Net Force by Tom Clancy

The assassination of the director of Net Force hurtles Deputy Director Alex Michaels into the perilous world of international intrigue as he confronts a deadly gang of cyberterrorists who are sabotaging mainframe computers across the country, leaving chaos and death in their wake.

Zenith Angle by Bruce Sterling

In a tale by the author of Tomorrow Now, top cybersecurity theorist Derek Vanderveer finds his life permanently disrupted by the events of September 11, after which he accepts a job with a new national security agency to determine who is attacking a top-secret U.S. satellite.
