Abraham Lincoln Vampire Hunter by Seth Grahame-Smith

In this alternate history, Lincoln learns at an early age that his mother was killed by a supernatural predator. This provokes a bloody lifelong vendetta against vampires and their slave-owning allies.

All Souls Trilogy by Deborah Harkness

Book one, *A Discovery of Witches*, is a story of passion and obsession. Diana Bishop, a young scholar and descendant of witches, discovers a long lost and alchemical manuscript. Its reappearance summons a fantastical underworld, which she navigates with her leading man, vampire geneticist Matthew Clairmont. The story continues in book two, *Shadow of Night*.

Aunt Dimity: Vampire Hunter by Nancy Atherton

Concerned for her preschooler twins' safety in the face of tales about a pale, blood-stained figure lurking in the nearby woods, Lori consults with her not-quite-departed Aunt Dimity and stumbles upon the truth about a forty-year-old murder.

Circle Trilogy Series by Nora Roberts

This is a romance vampire series which includes *Morrigan's Cross*, *The Dance of the Gods* and *Valley of Silence*.

Daughter of Darkness by V.C. Andrews

One night, with the sound of a young man's scream, high school senior Lorelei discovers that her stern but loving father, who adopted Lorelei and her sisters as infants, is no ordinary man. He has raised his beautiful girls for one purpose: to lure young men into their world of shadows.

Dracula by Bram Stoker

The classic tale of the bizarre Carpathian count, who drinks human blood to stay alive, and the Englishman who knows his secret.

Insatiable Series by Meg Cabot (Princess Diaries)

Meena Harper has been cursed from birth with the "gift" of knowing how everyone she meets is going to die, until she finally meets a guy who doesn't seem to have an expiration date. Have her dreams come true...or her worse nightmare just begun?

The Vampire Chronicles by Ann Rice

Book one, *Interview with the Vampire*, centers on vampire Louis de Pointe du Lac who tells the story of his life and how he was seduced into a life of immortality by the selfishly evil vampire Lestat. Other titles include: *The Vampire Lestat*, *The Queen of the Damned*, *The Tale of the Body Thief*, *Memnoch the Devil*, *The Vampire Armand*, *Merrick*, *Blood and Gold*, *Blackwood Farm*, and *Blood Canticle*.

Libriomancer (Magic Ex Libris Book 1) by Jim C. Hines

Isaac Vainio is a member of the secret organization founded five centuries ago by Johannes Gutenberg. Libriomancers are gifted with the ability to magically *reach* into books and draw forth objects. When Isaac is attacked by vampires that *leaked* from the pages of books into our world, he barely manages to escape. To his horror he discovers that vampires have been attacking other magic-users as well.

Shakespeare, Undead by Lori Handeland

Zombies have invaded 1592 London and it's up to William Shakespeare, whose genius with a quill comes from his extended life as a vampire, to stop them. Aided by Katherine, a zombie hunter to whom he is consummately, perilously attracted. The story of Will and Katherine continue in the sequel *Zombie Island*.

Sookie Stackhouse Series by Charlaine Harris

Sookie is a cocktail waitress in Bon Temps, Louisiana where vampires have "come out of the coffin." Inspiration for the HBO series *True Blood*.

The Strain Trilogy Series by Guillermo del Toro

The first first installment, *The Strain*, follows an epic struggle for survival between humans and vampires, a tale that is set against a backdrop of the post-World War II era in eastern Europe and America.

Twilight Series by Stephenie Meyer

When seventeen-year-old Bella leaves Phoenix to live with her father in Forks, Washington, she meets an exquisitely handsome boy at school for whom she feels an overwhelming attraction and who she comes to realize is not wholly human.
